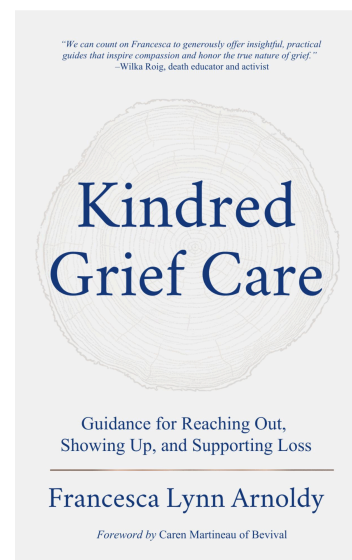
Kindred Grief Care
